As a result, there are no basic school fees for 2020/2021

The Division has been directed through Ministerial Order to

- Cease charging fees or costs for textbooks, workbooks, photocopying, printing or paper supplies.
- Only charge amounts to cover projected costs of providing for the subject matter of the charge.
- Post each school's approved fee schedule on the school's website.

ALTERNATE TRANSPORTATION (students who require a seat on more than one bus – the appropriate partially funded or unfunded fee applied to each seat on each bus – conditional on whether there is room on the second bus)	\$100.00 or \$250.00	\$200.00 or \$500.00
FAMILIES WITH 2 OR MORE CHILDREN	(the first two children of the lesser fees are full fee and the 3 rd and subsequent child is 50% of the designated fee)
