Online Kindergarten Registration:

The Superintendent reported on the Online Kindergarten Registration process that is currently being piloted in the three elementary schools in Sylvan Lake, with general Online Kindergarten Registration for all schools getting underway division-wide on January 21st. The effort to provide this new opportunity for parents to register their child online has required years of collaborating and refining processes across multiple departments in Chinook's Edge, and the Superintendent voiced appreciation to staff for their efforts in learning and streamlining the new process. This work is allowing the division to launch accessible online registration services for Chinook's Edge families for the first time.

Alberta School Councils Conference:

The Board wishes to show support for the important work that School Councils undertake by providing support for a limited number of Chinook's Edge School Council reps to attend the Conference and AGM in Edmonton through a draw process. Trustees directed the Superintendent to send an email to each School Council to gather expressions of interest in receiving support to attend the conference, which takes place from April 26-28.

First Quarter Financial Report:
