Carstairs—building a plan together:

Trustee Sheldon Ball provided an update on this ad hoc committee of the Board, which has met regularly in an effort to clarify short-term challenges and long-term visioning around grade configurations at Chinook's Edge schools in Carstairs. It was reported that the process has been positive and helpful in clarifying options to deal with rapid community growth and the resulting school space issues. The committee is expected to make a recommendation to the Board in February, for a long-term plan they would like the Board to advocate to the provincial government.
