

Grand opening of new learning spaces at Carstairs Elementary School



The Carstairs Elementary School community is celebrating their new learning spaces, which were officially opened a week ago with a visit from The Honourable Nathan Cooper, MLA for Olds-Didsbury-Three Hills. He presented a government plaque to Board Chair Holly Bilton, which will be displayed in the school. Officials cut the ribbon to acknowledge the end of a long project: Vice Principal Lara Pawluk, Trustee Melissa Copley, Principal John Goutsis and Associate Superintendent Corporate Services Shawn Russell.
