Transportation overview:

Director Corinne Varga provided an overview of the past year in the Transportation Dept. In her first year in the role, Corinne has worked to build relationships and trust among bus drivers and to ensure they know how much they are appreciated. Corinne had been a bus driver earlier in her career and has a strong compassion for the role. Also, cameras had been installed in all buses this year and have been valuable in supporting safety. Cameras are helpful when working with RCMP if vehicles drive through red flashing lights and they have also helped to support student management on buses. Along with ensuring the priority for safety, Corinne is closely monitoring increasing costs of fuel, parts and other budget items. She praised the skill and integrity of the bus shop staff and everyone in the Transportation Dept.
